



## TARGETS:

- 1. Have halted by 2015 and begun to reverse the spread of HIV/AIDS;*
- 2. Have halted by 2015 and begun reverse the incidence of tuberculosis and other major diseases*

## STATUS OF PROGRESS:

FYR Macedonia is among the countries with the lowest incidence rate of clinically diagnosed AIDS in the region and Europe. The HIV/AIDS cases have had an oscillating positive development tendency between 1987 and 2007 with peaks in 1994, 1998 and 2006. Downward trends of tuberculosis incidence support the assumptions that the target will be reached by 2015; there was a significant drop of TB incidence between 1990 and 2007. Malaria was declared eradicated in the country in 1972.
